- Entries must be returned to the School or phoned in to a committee member no later than March 21st.
- Entry fee of \$1.00 (per team member) must accompany each entry.
- Skips will be contacted Thursday evening (March 23rd) by the committee members to inform them of their playing times. It will be each Skip's responsibility to inform team members of draw times Saturday.

TEAMS

- Each team must consist of four players (girls and/or boys). **If you do not have a full team we will find other players for you.**
- Children unable to go onto the ice alone are too young to participate. Parents are not allowed onto the ice surface.
 - Leads must be in grade 2 or lower; Seconds must be in grade 4 or lower
 - Vice must be in grade 6 or lower; Skips must be in grade 8 or lower
- All teams must begin with four players. The skip may not play more than 2 rocks per end.
- If a rock overturns it must be removed from play immediately.
- Players will not be allowed to switch positions during the game.
- TEAMS NOT FOLLOWING THESE RULES WILL BE PLACED LAST
